Literacy

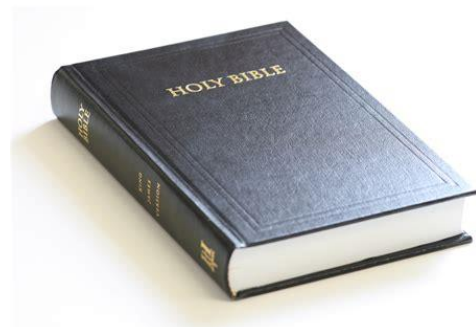
